Walter A.H. Rossing



Walter A.H. Rossing is associate professor on Agro-ecology and Farming Systems at the Farming Systems Ecology group of Wageningen University in the Netherlands. He obtained his PhD from Wageningen University in 1993 on a topic combining theoretical production ecology, plant disease epidemiology and operations research. He continued to work in and lead interdisciplinary research projects on ecological intensification and agro-ecology at the field, farm and landscape levels. Projects commonly involve both social and natural scientists. Current research themes include diversification of cropping systems in time and space, beef cattle production on natural grasslands and organic vegetable food systems, situated in Europe, Chile and Uruguay. In all projects development of methods to effectively develop and use scientific knowledge for action is an important element, with co-innovation as a common denominator.
